

Certificate IV Security Industry Firearms Instructor Course



National Accreditation

This is the first program of this nature to receive national accreditation under the Australian Recognition Framework (ARF). It was approved by the ACT Accreditation and Registration Council on the 18th June 1997, it has also been approved by the Victorian Police Commissioner and the Australian Federal Police (AFP) for licencing. It is recognised in Tasmania. The course holds mutual recognition with VETAB.

Pre-assessment

All candidates are assessed prior to the course. This is done through a face-to-face assessment, a written questionnaire and a Pre-assessment Shoot. This enables the Instructors to work with you at the level you are at, not an assumed level of competence.

Entry Requirements

- be proficient in the use of a revolver (and semiautomatic pistol if required).
- write an essay introducing yourself.
- have completed the School Certificate (Year 10/4th Form) or higher.
- Be 18 years or older.
- Hold (or be eligible to hold) a Firearms Licence (according to state legislation).

Senior First Aid

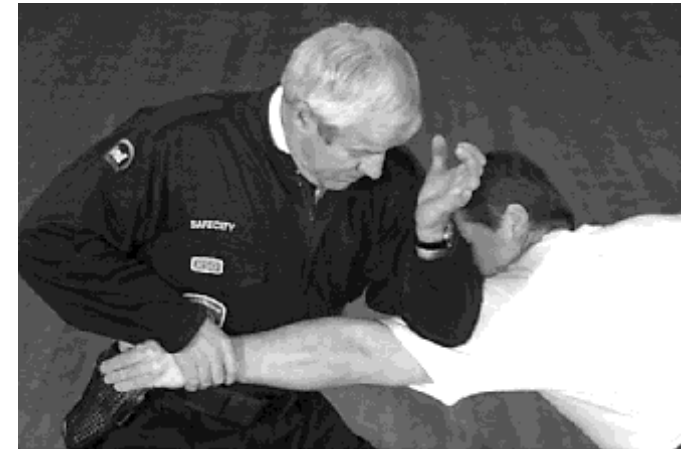
This is a requirement for the course and is available through Safecity. There is a special module on needle stick injuries, knife wounds and gunshot wounds.

Once licenced in Victoria, you may issue your own certificates, or buy registration pack and obtain the Statement of Attainment *Handle Firearms* for your students.

Course Duration and Accreditation

The course is 12 days and includes Instructor Development, revolver and semiautomatic (optional). The accreditation is valid for 3 (three) years.

When and where we conduct the courses

The courses have been conducted since 1996, and are held regularly in Victoria and the Australian Capital Territory.

Role Plays and Demonstrations

There are many opportunities for the candidates to conduct lectures and range drills. This is done under the careful observation and guidance of the Course Directors. Positive and practical feedback is provided on an individual basis in a non threatening manner.
