

Frequently Asked Questions

My friend said he has seen "the cheap ones" and they are no good. This is an entirely new product – being released in Australia for the first time. The special introductory price will be adjusted and we expect the baton to retail at a competitive price once the introductory period is over.

What happens if I don't like the baton when I receive it? Simply return the baton in mint condition (that means the box, the baton and the pouch are in the same condition as you received them) within 7 days of the day of receipt and we will refund the price of baton.

What does the grip feel like? The specially designed hyper-grip compound rubber grip provides you with a firm yet comfortable feel to the hand. The grip is not spongy and will not soak in moisture. Because it is not made of foam, you will not get that wet, tacky feeling.

What are the bumps on the grip? Will they feel uncomfortable in my hand? The special hyper-grip bumps on the handle are soft and will not cause discomfort. They are a unique feature found in our batons which provides a powerful grip even when your hands are sweaty or wet.

How will you send the baton? We use registered, insured mail. You will have to sign for your baton at the post office.

What does the warranty cover? We guarantee that the baton is delivered to you free of any faults of defects in manufacture. Each baton is inspected and tested before delivery. You will find the initials of the inspector on the box. Safecity will replace or repair a baton if you find a defect of manufacture. Warranty does not cover wear and tear, parts such as the retention clip, or damages as a result of use or misuse of the baton. Just like you would not expect your car manufacturer to replace your car after an accident, or your car tyres and battery every 12 months.

What is Safecity's "Defender Warranty"? If you are involved in a defensive incident where your Safecity expandable baton helps you avoid injuries and you are willing to allow us to publish the event, we will replace your baton with a new one at a special discount price. Contact Safecity and we will send you a special release form, send the completed form with your old baton and payment and we will send your new baton by return mail.

My friend was taught that the best way to collapse an expandable is by tapping it on the side to loosen the joints. This is not recommended and will void your warranty. This method will damage the tapered joints of any expandable baton. The correct method is shown in your instruction manual. Copies of the manual can also be downloaded from our web site.

I don't have a credit card. How do I order? You can fill in and detach the order form on this brochure and mail it to us with payment (cheque or money order).

When will I receive the baton? When you order from us you should allow 7 to 14 days delivery. We always try to process orders within 24 hours. However, we cannot guarantee the delivery time. Your credit card will not be charged until the order has been sent. However, we will request for an authorization for payment on your credit card. This does not actually charge your credit card but guarantees payment when we send the baton.

Do I need a licence to buy a baton? Expandable batons are weapons that can be concealed. Safecity will only retail batons to law enforcement, security and authorised persons. Before we can ship the baton to you, we will require a copy of your security licence or letter of authorization from a Government agency. In Australia, expandable batons are prohibited weapons in most states. In NSW we will require a copy of your Class 1A licence or Commissioner's Permit. In the ACT only employers of security guards may purchase batons.

Do I need training? Yes. We strongly recommend that you undertake a police approved training course with an authorised instructor. This may also be a requirement for licensing in your State. Your Certificate should show the words "Approved by the NSW Police Commissioner and VETAB" Safecity conducts police approved nationally recognised baton instructor training.

How do I store the expandable baton? You should treat your expandable baton as you would a firearm. In NSW it is a requirement that expandable batons be stored in the same way you would store a Class A rifle (rim fire). This means you should store the baton in a lock able metal container (or heavy wooden chest), preferably bolted to the floor, too heavy to be moved or in a locked room.
